MARSHALL COUNTY ARTS COMMISSION INVITES ARTISTS TO ENTER THE SPRING SHOW

Original works of art are to be in keeping with the theme, "Authentic Kentucky".

Entry fee: \$10 per artist with a limit of three pieces of work and may be paid when the artwork is delivered.

Accepting Artwork April 22, 2010. Art work may be picked up on Monday, April 26, 2010 with proper identification.

RULES OF ELIGIBILITY

Artists may enter up to three pieces of 2D or 3D work. All media or mixed media may be used. Pick up declined work on Friday, April 23. The work must be the original work of the artist. It may be done from a photograph, but it must not be the copied work of another artist. Each piece of work must be ready for public viewing and easels must be provided by the artist. Tables will be available for 3D work. No work may exceed three feet in any direction in size. Each entry must have an attached ID tag to the lower right-hand corner of work. Accepted artwork MUST remain on display the duration of the exhibit.

AWARDS

All entry money will be returned in awards and amounts will be determined by the number of entries.

Best of Show—Judges' choice.

Best of Show—Public's choice .

Best in media—photography, oils-acrylics-water color, sculpture, fabric.
